1. Resolution No. 14-2021-2022 to Approve Adjusted Trustee Area Boundary Plan

Viar noted every 10 years a census is conducted to review boundaries and to ensure the population is balanced within Trustee area boundaries. Doug Johnson of the National Demographics Corporation worked with Glendale Community College to consider the boundaries and provide options. Each option ensures that population variances do not exceed 10% between the smallest and largest area, do not violate rights to vote for populations of race or color, and that boundaries are compact, cohesive, avoid gerrymandering, and topographically balanced.

The Board inquired about how the community will be notified if their voting boundary had changed. Viar noted the sample ballot for the next election will indicate the new boundary for those impacted.

It was moved (Benlian) and seconded (Ransford) to adopt Resolution No. 14-2021-2022 to approve the adjusted trustee area boundary plan as outlined in Option A Plan.

The motion passed unanimously.
