

FAFSA FSA ID

The FSA ID is a username and password used by students, parents, and borrowers to log into and electronically sign the FAFSA.

Who needs to create & use an FSA ID

- Students filing FAFSA
- Parent(s) of dependent student filing FAFSA

What is needed to successfully create FSA

- Student name as it appears on SSN card
- Parent(s) name as it appears on SSN card
- Student SSN
- Parent(s) SSN
- Student personal email*
- Parent(s) persona email
- Student mobile number
- Parent mobile number

*Note: Do NOT use school email as you will lose access after graduation!

FSA TIPS!

- Make sure names input in FSA ID match the name on SSN card
- Remember, do NOT use school emails for any applications including the creation of FSA ID
- A parent may already have an FSA ID if they were a student or had a prior child in college.
- Write down your username, password, and challenge questions. Keep them somewhere safe.
- Parents without a social security number cannot create an FSA ID; they will sign the FAFSA my printing out and mailing our the signature page to:
