Eligibility: We seek innovative and dynamic proposals from Higher Ed professionals, change agents, practitioners, and community leaders that reflect our mission.

Application process: Your proposal should include your title, student-learning outcomes, and preferred format (i.e., workshop, roundtable, etc.). Please include a brief abstract describing your presentation, desired student-learning outcomes, and its relation to the summit mission. Presenters should be prepared to broadcast their sessions over zoom.

Format options: IDEA sessions include peer-to-peer learning sessions, roundtable discussions, workshops, and panel discussions.
