**WHAT IS EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY?**

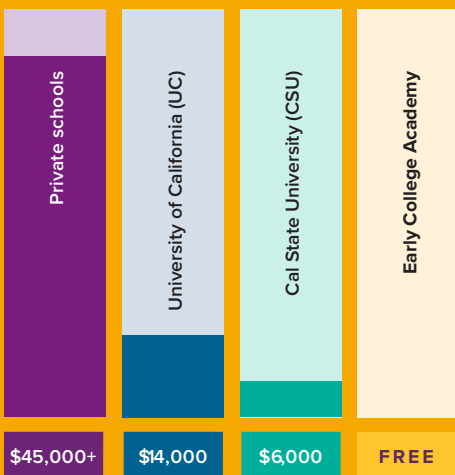
