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	Palermo: The course content in this course is very similar to our Math 136 course. Why is this course needed when they can just take Math 136?								
	Dulay: We used the same model from the C-ID. A person with an FSA in math can also teach this class. In addition, it creates more options for students.								
	Cortes: A person can teach this course by only having an FSA in math? Wouldn't we want someone with background information in the subject?								
	Dulay: The FSA is just the minimum qualifications.								
	Talaoc: There is no C-ID listed.								
	Mack: We are applying for it.								
	Talaoc: The greater concern here is that if we give this class the math C-ID descriptor, then we are saying Math 136 and this class are equivalent. How detailed do you go into each topic?								
	It was questioned how much of the material is the same between both classes, and mentioned that there would not be a great concern if this class was not given the math C-ID descriptor. In addition, it was mentioned to possibly have a credit limitation note, but was discussed how it may limit other options for students.
