## 2019 Curriculum Institute Report (Rohrbacher/Traynor)

Some information that was gathered at the Institute was that we should review the vision or mission statement periodically, courses with prerequisites being added or changed need to have a second motion as well. C&I should hold a retreat, meeting, or training about Guided Pathways, AB 705, and other things besides curriculum items. It is important to advertise new courses and programs.

## **Articulation update (Cortes)**

We are having a C-ID challenge because we have to constantly check if any changes have been made. The reviewers don't get notifications. AB 1786- All community colleges have expanded the credit by exam policy to credit by prior learning. The Chancellor's office said to accept subjects that military and veterans have been bringing. There will be a pure distinction with credit by exam and courses taken here. For the TMC site, Google TMC Chancellor's Office and it is the 1st link. **Traynor:** When completing TMCs, make sure they all look the same and also look at the outline to make sure it is current.
