What Do We Expect from a COR—Course Content (Rohrbacher)

From the PCAH (2017): “Content, in terms of a specific body of knowledge, should depict the scope and depth of topics or subjects to be covered by the course” (p. 24).

- The course content usually takes the form of an outline
- One or two pages in length
- The topics in the outline should relate to the course objectives
- Do not copy the titles of chapters from a textbook associated for the course. Instead, organize your content in outline format, with main topics and subtopics, if any
- Leave wiggle room—make topics broad enough to include multiple approaches
- Course topics and subtopics should be brief and should be written as topics rather than as complete sentences
- Use bullet points when identifying subtopic
- Include hours for all main topics
