What Do We Expect from a COR-Entry Standards (Rohrbacher)

- Encompass the skills students will likely need to succeed in a course.
- Can be the exit standards from the precondition for enrollment (requisite or advisories on recommended preparation) Kretzmann: should this be worded as "must" or "should" be the exits standards from preconditions? Rohrbacher: Yes—I think that's reasonable
- Can be self-designed if no preconditions for enrollment, usually for introductory level courses
- Shouldn't be confused with course notes

Kretzmann: Can it be that we have entry standards but we don't use them and create new ones instead.

Rohrbacher: We must include at least some entry standards from recommendations. In regard to some classes having "read at a college level" it really depends on the class.
