Upload the transfer model documentation on the 1st page of CMS. This is useful information for advisory minutes, labor market information, C-ID report, CTE, and CRC. Upload all the information here.

Cortes: SB 1440.org is where you can find the TMC table. Click on "Curriculum Information" and under "Degree Submission Information" click on second link (TMC Templates for submitting AA-T and AS-T Degrees"

What Do We Expect from a COR—Prerequisites and Recommended Preps (Rohrbacher)
