II. Ongoing Business

The Role of C&I in promoting DEIA. Francien shared what other California community colleges, such as Hartnell College and Las Positas College, are doing to promote DEIA in their curriculum, and the link to a webinar of the ASCCC Guided Pathways Taskforce. She suggested discussing the committee's plan to further promote DEIA at the September 8th C&I meeting, which should have a light agenda. She would like to reach out to Dr. Ritterbrown, Academic Senate Pres. Roger Dickes, and April Bey, chair of the Academic Senate DEI Subcommittee, about having a DEI rep to serve as a resource person in C&I.

Daphne Dionisio, Innovation Grant Director, asked Francien about creating Canvas lessons built around the equity guide. Francien will forward names to Daphne. Please let her know if you may be interested. (ACCJC Standard II.A.7)

III. <u>New Business</u>

Articulation Update. Richard sent the list of GE review decisions. Ethnic Studies courses were denied. Richard will work with Instructor Fabiola Torres to get them approved. Francien will forward Richard's email with the GE decisions to the whole committee.

Program Learning Outcomes (Ybarra). Yvette and reps have been working on creating PLOs which follow a Guided Pathways direction. Maria Kretzmann's Biology courses, for example, have skill-based and attainment-based PLOs. Chris Herwerth's Engineering courses have PLOs for low skill certificates. A good question to ask is "What's the end game for our students?" Yvette spoke to Ed Karpp and Daphne Dionisio; it will take a semester to get attainment results. Distance Education Addenda Deadline (Rooney). Piper reiterated that any course which is scheduled to be offered in the Summer will need its DE Addendum with its COR. Courses which will be approved in C&I on June 9 will be sent to the DE Addendum subcommittee for approval when they meet June 11. Piper sent a link to the DE Addendum form and explained how to complete it. She also listed the courses which may need attention. (ACCJC Standard II.A.1)

Integrate DE Addendum in CMS. Francien, Piper, Alexa and Pedro have been talking about a way to integrate DE Addendum in the curriculum management system, which would streamline the whole process.
