For degree revisions, if the template asks for an Articulation Agreement by Major (AAM), have them ready and upload them directly into CMS. Dr. Cortes or Francien can help you with this if you need tips.

Additionally, make sure you've filled out the state's most up-to-date template which will need to be submitted with the degree revision.

Finally, make sure that the following fields in the program revision form are filled out for program revisions:

- Catalog statement (these should already be in our print catalog—do not modify)
- Program goals (Nancy should have a copy of these)
- Program learning outcomes (these should already be in our print catalog—do not modify)
- Program requirements and program schedule
- If possible, complete all additional fields in the program revision form to have them in place as we may be asked for these when Nancy submits the program (we've been given inconsistent information about what's required)

For a new ADT all of the fields above *including all AAMS required and the program template* must be completed as well as any additional fields in the new program form.
