Call to Order

II. Ongoing Business

The role of C&I in promoting DEIA (ACCJC Standard II.A.7)

DEIA resource person on C&I. Francien contacted Counselor Alexandra Evans about being the DEI resource person in C&I. Please let Francien know if you or someone you know may be interested.

Equity Guide Workshops. Francien will hold an Intro to the Equity Guide workshop on October 14, 2021, at 2 p.m. If you are interested in being a co-presenter, please contact Francien.

DE Addendum in CMS (Rooney, Rohrbacher) (ACCJC Standard II.A.1)

Piper shared the links to the DE Addendum form and to the guide. The DE Addendum is now live on CMS in the Supplementals section. The Math Division filled out the first batch and they went through CMS. Piper has asked the Academic Senate to approve the creation of a DE Subcommittee, whose responsibility would be to review and approve course proposals for DE Addenda twice a month. CoDE meets once a month while course proposals are approved at C&I twice a month.

Piper confirmed that CORs with existing DE Addendum will not be held back. Francien clarified that it is the new CORs and courses undergoing substantial change which will have to go through the approval process, including Academic Affairs. When she sends out emails to C&I reps after every C&I meeting regarding the approval or status of their course proposals, she will also advise them whether the COR needs a DE Addendum. At the CoDE meeting on the 28th, Francien will explain to CoDE reps the process of CMS approval. She has given CMS access to CoDE reps.

A suggestion was made to create an additional section, Section 7, in CMS to house the DE Addendum for each course instead of having it in the Supplementals, to make the approval process more transparent and more accessible.

III. New Business

Library Liaison feature in CMS (Conner-Gaten, Rohrbacher). Aisha is working with Pedro, the CMS technician, regarding the installation of the Library Liaison feature in CMS. Aisha will discuss at the next meeting.

Articulation (Cortes). For those course proposals which were not approved for UC transferability, the deadline for appeal starts October 1st through the 11th. Richard would like to submit those.

PeopleSoft Query (Traynor, Rohrbacher). Nancy ran a PeopleSoft query to isolate courses which require an update on their recommended preps or prerequisites to align with what we currently offer in English and/or Math. Courses which are not transfer-level cannot be listed as prerequisites, only as recommended preps. For example, if you have courses which list ENGL 120 or ENGL 191 as a prerequisite, or eligibility for ENGL 101, or courses which list MATH 115 as a prerequisite, they will need to be updated. Francien will send out the list of outdated recommended preps or prerequisites. Please update and send through this semester. These are updates, not cyclical and are not part of the October 7th deadline but we would like them to come through for inclusion in the next catalog. These are impacting students' ability to enroll in classes. (ACCJC Standard II.A.16)
