Call to Order

C&I Committee Co-Chair Francien Rohrbacher called the meeting to order at 2:06 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

MSC (McDonald/Kretzmann) to approve the minutes of June 9, 2021 Curriculum & Instruction Committee with minor corrections.

I. <u>Announcements</u>

Preliminary Review. The next Preliminary Review deadline is September 10, 2021. The last Preliminary Review deadline for Fall is October 7, 2021. Francien will hold office hours tomorrow, September 9, instead of Friday (Faculty Institute Day). If you have any questions or would like to discuss your course proposal, please meet with her on Zoom.

Cyclical Revisions due Fall 2021 and Spring 2022. Please check the lists for courses which are due to expire this semester or in the Spring. The Spring 2022 list is long because it includes courses which came through in June, July or August 2020 for DE Addenda. CoDE and C&I are working to align due dates. Please let Francien know if there are discrepancies in the due dates or if your records indicate otherwise.

Please check the Programs which have been listed at the end of every meeting agenda for the past 2 years. Some do not have catalog description and others need revised, updated or shortened catalog descriptions. Guided Pathways will use this for the program mapper in Navigate.

II. Ongoing Business

Role of C&I in promoting DEIA. Last year, C&I formed a task force which created the Equity Guide. Francien and other committee members co-facilitated DEIA workshops and hope to continue leading DEIA workshops this year. (ACCJC Standard II.A.7)

It has been strongly recommended by the Chancellor's Office to have a DEIA resource person in C&I and, in our case, it would benefit to have DEIA experience and input in Tech Review. Francien will reach out to adjunct counselor Alexandra Evans and ask if she may be interested to serve as DEIA resource person.

III. New Business

Academic Senate Curriculum Institute, July 2021. The takeaways from the general sessions, panel discussions and breakout sessions of this year's Curriculum Institute were discussed. They included:

- Deciding how to align our CORs and DE addenda is a local decision.
- Ethnic Studies is going to be a graduation requirement for associate degrees.
- No update on the Chancellor's Office decision to move to a new curriculum database
- Equitable placement results show that student outcomes have improved across all metrics but the focus remains on outcomes and closing the equity gap. Do these metrics account for the enrollment drop since COVID?
- Guided Pathways. Divisions should review CORs and programs to "clean house"
- CBE (Competency Based Education) will be implemented soon. Eight colleges doing pilots of CBE programs
- AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering System)
- CPL (Credit for Prior Learning): useful for mirrored courses
- CE programs must be reviewed every two years and include program narrative, CORs, LMI within 2 years from date of proposal/revision, AOCRC approval, Advisory Board minutes
- 2022 Curriculum Institute will be held on July 6-9 in Riverside

Articulation (Cortes). Richard will continue to serve as Articulation Officer. No replacement has been selected.

DE Addendum in CMS (Rohrbacher, Rooney). Distance Education Addendum will be incorporated in CMS. Piper introduced the newly revised and Senate-approved DE Addendum form, which will be housed in the Supplementals section of each course proposal in CMS. The old form in Google Doc had to be revised because it did not meet Title 5 or Ed Code requirements, specifically how SLOs will be met and

assessed in the online modality. C&I reps will hopefully work closely with their division CoDE reps this first month to familiarize them with CMS. Francien will assign online access to CoDE reps and, at the September 28 CoDE meeting, she will walk them through CMS. The new form was beta-tested and contained glitches. Piper will contact the CMS technician, Pedro. It was suggested that the DE Addendum form be filled out after the course proposal is approved in C&I, to avoid confusion.

Ethnic Studies Graduation Requirement (Cortes, Ritterbrown, Rohrbacher, Traynor). Students seeking an associate degree will be required to complete a course in ethnic studies as part of their general education. This will impact AD-Ts and local degrees. Implementation is not expected until Fall 2023. We will be waiting for more information guidance from the Chancellor's Office. Dr. Ritterbrown explained that unless the State allows us to expand the number of unit requirements for AD-Ts, an addition of units or course, such as Ethnic Studies, would mean the elimination of another course.
