

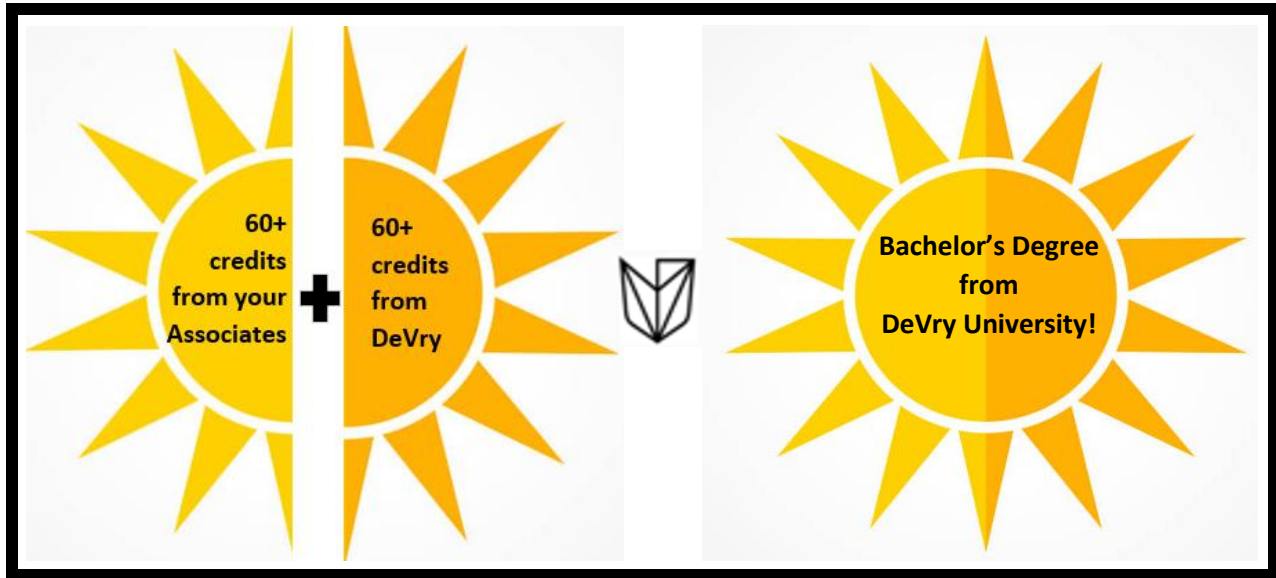


NEW! Transfer Advantage60 Pledge

DeVry University is pleased to offer our new Transfer Advantage60 Pledge for students to block transfer 60 credit hours from their conferred associate degree into one of two qualifying DeVry Bachelor's programs.



DeVry's Transfer Advantage60 Pledge allows for a 60-credit hour block transfer through a quick and friendly admissions process. If you have a qualifying associate degree, you may be eligible to seamlessly transfer the 60 college credits you've earned to DeVry University from one of our partner community colleges to pursue a bachelor's degree in Business Administration or Technical Management. In fact, you may even be able to transfer up to 90 total qualifying credits, pending an evaluation. To be eligible for the Transfer Advantage60 Pledge, students must meet DeVry University's admissions requirements and have completed a qualifying associate degree at a community college that has a signed agreement with DeVry University. The minimum credit hours for graduation are: 124 for the Bachelor's of Science in Business Administration and 122 for the Bachelor's of Science in Technical Management.
