The Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) provides services and advocacy resulting in competitive employment in integrated work settings, independent living such as transition services, housing assistance, and personal assistance services, and equality for individuals with disabilities.



Verdugo Jobs Center (VJC) offers programs to connect the Verdugo region's job seekers— including individuals with disabilities, those experiencing homelessness, and veterans—with professional development opportunities and valuable resources.



The Career Education (CE) department (sometimes called Career and Technical Education or CTE) includes educational programs designed to connect students more directly to the workforce. CE programs are informed by regional labor market needs and industry professionals and can often offer shorter timelines to completion than many other college programs, though they can also be a starting point to other career pathways that lead to Bachelor's and graduate degrees.
