


Instructions to screen-shot your Loan Summary, Complete your Loan MPN, Entrance and Exit Counseling

Go to: ***Studentaid.gov***

(For Windows or Apple you will have to use the latest release: Chrome, Firefox, MS Edge or Safari)

-Log in with your FAFSA Username and Password.




What to screenshot for Loan summary:

All borrowers will have to screenshot their loan aid summary and attach a copy to their Loan Request Form (please do NOT click on “Download My Aid Data”).

For students who have borrowed loans previously:


The screenshot below is adequate to submit for students who have borrowed loans previously, once you log into Studentaid.gov. Make sure your loan summary is visible in the screenshot:


