

Join GCC professors Zohara Kaye and Sevada Chamras on this 2-week exploration of the culture and society of Armenia. Students must enroll in Library International Field Studies (1 unit).

The program will be based in central Yerevan, Armenia, the "Pink City." The program will include visits to sites of cultural and historical significance - including UNESCO world heritage sites of Etchmiadzin, Geghard, Haghpat, and Sanahin - along with lectures and discussions.

Program Includes: 13 nights accommodation at Holiday Inn Express in Yerevan based on twin occupancy. Daily breakfast, 4 lunches, welcome dinner, farewell dinner, airport transfers and land transportation as part of the program itinerary. Entry to cultural sites including Yerevan city tour, History Museum of Armenia, and Matenadaran. Other sites are Tsitsernakabert, Gami Pagan Temple, Zami-Pami Cave Castle, Akhtala Fortress, Carahunge ("Armenian Stonehenge"), and an overnight trip to the serene town of Dilijan ("Armenian Switzerland").

Not Included: Airfare of approximately \$1,600+, GCC tuition & fees, textbooks, beverages, meals & activities not part of the itinerary, travel insurance (approx. \$100), spending money (approx. \$400).
