eLumen Updates

- Timeline for verifying CORs
 - o October-November: C&I Reps and faculty review and verify CORs in eLumen (deadline to verify CORs is Nov. 30)
 - Please note: We are expecting ALL (100%) CORs to be verified by C&I Reps and faculty by Nov. 30.
 - We will not be reviewing new or cyclical revisions of CORs until all existing CORs have been verified.
 - o October-December: Nancy, Bridget, and Francien review and verify coding (Nancy), Articulation Information (Bridget) and double-checking everything else (Francien).
 - o December: Nancy, Bridget, and Francien finish their reviews; Nancy finalizes all CORs in eLumen
- When can we start submitting new curriculum or cyclical reviews?
 - o Spring 2023 (first prelim review deadline is January 17, 2023) for CORs.
 - o Programs TBA—most likely February or March 2023
 - o Preliminary Review and Technical Review trainings will happen in November/December 2022.

 - o DEIA work is a necessity
 - Students want curricular change
