Amir Nour, Interim Vice President of Administrative Services, presented the proposed 2022-2023 budget and provided details related to budget implications, projections, expenditure mitigation, and budget cautions. The proposed budget includes what is currently budgeted; however, GCC will continue to work with its constituencies to identify savings in the 2022-2023 budget with the goal of closing deficits and bringing the

reserve balance to the required 6% by the end of fall 2022. The Board will continue to consider the proposed budget prior to final action at the Tuesday, September 13, 2022 board meeting.
