COVID-19 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The Glendale Community College District (District) is committed to protecting the health and wellbeing of students, faculty, staff, administrators, and the communities it serves, as well as maintaining higher education access and attainment for its students. Due to the persisting nature and regularly evolving conditions of the pandemic, the District must effectuate a responsive policy that supports a safe environment and provides flexibility for the District to fulfill its core academic mission, and meet its obligations to maintain access for the community it serves. As the District continues to ensure a safe environment for on campus learning, working and other activities, it will sustain reasonable measures to minimize the likelihood of transmission of the COVID-19 virus and its variants in the college community.

All employees, students and visitors to campuses and district facilities and vendors and contracted individuals working at District facilities must comply with all Cal/OSHA safety guidelines and standards, County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health Orders of the Health Officer, and other District policies and procedures, as well as any other District COVID-19 health and safety protocols in effect. Such health and safety protocols may include requiring vaccinations.

The Superintendent/President is authorized to adopt and, as deemed appropriate, amend District procedures and campus protocols related to preventing the transmission of COVID-19 which are consistent with all active Department of Public Health requirements until the COVID-19 pandemic is no longer declared to be a public health emergency in Los Angeles County.
