1. Placement and Assessment

- The International officeIs in the processOfUpdating their online application.
- The new and improved program will have better integration with the PeopleSoft software.
- The bill, AB1705, has been passed.

- This allows students to go straight into transfer courses with a few exceptions.
- It will also help close equity gaps.
- The bill also requires community colleges to provide extra resources such as tutoring.

2. Enrollment Management

- Enrollment has increased compared to previous years.
 - More evening classes are going to be added since it helped with enrollment.
- A new marketing team is being added since there was a disconnect between students and the marketing team.
 - This will improve the connection between the administration and the students.
- Considering adding internships on campus, creating more guided pathways, and offering
 Biology as a non-major asynchronous class.

3. Institutional Planning Coord.

- Enrollment Is increased by 6% non-credit and for credit is down by 12.1% from the previous year.
- It was found that the eight week courses offered are helpful for students.

- The dream office reported that the DACA program is in danger of closing down due to policy being in question by the Supreme Court.
