Eid'e Nowruz, or Iranian New Year, is celebrated every year on the first day of spring. Celebrations last two weeks starting with fire jumping the

Wednesday before new year for good health (Charshambeh Sooree). During Nowruz (or "new day"), families set up a special table called the Haft Seen (or "Seven S'es") with symbols of good health, wealth, and longevity, eat traditional foods like herbed rice with smoked fish, and give out gifts or money to their loved ones. Thirteen days after Eid, the community gathers at local parks to end the festivities (Seezdeh Bedar), where people eat a special herb and bean soup called Ash Reshteh for additional blessings of good health.
