He graduated from the prestigious National Taiwan University with a degree in law and, following immigrating to the US, attended CalTech to receive a degree in Engineering. He worked at JPL for most of his career. His wife, Yemei Wang, is the professor who had the vision, insight and energy to create the Culinary Art program at Glendale Community College and she hired Chef Andrew Feldman. The Wang family continues to support the college with the participation of their daughter, Lisa who serves on the Foundation Board.

Also adjourned in memory of Ken Brown. Brown was the immediate-past president of the California Community College Trustees (CCCT) and served as its president from 2021-22, leading fellow trustees and colleagues as campuses returned from the pandemic. He joined the CCCT board in 2016 and served as a voice for trustees across California's 116 community colleges, guiding the board on positions and policy issues.

Brown had been President of the Governing Board of Trustees at El Camino Community College District in Torrance, California and had served at California State University of Dominguez Hills since 2002 as an adjunct professor of Physics teaching Physical Science and Science, Math, and Technology (SMT). Brown leaves behind his wife of 21 years and their two sons.
