



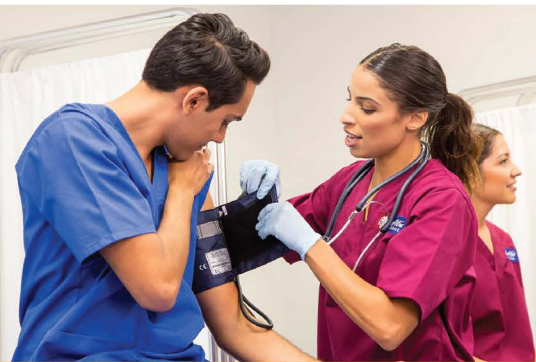

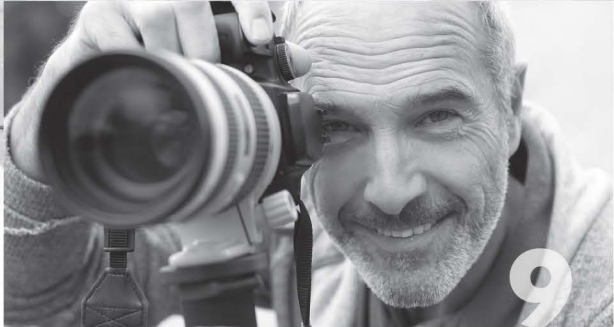

IN-PERSON COURSE

Phlebotomy Technician

Phlebotomy Technicians are in demand as one of the fastest growing occupations in healthcare. Launch your career as a Phlebotomy Technician, collecting blood samples from patients in a hospital, clinical laboratory, medical office, or clinic. Through lectures and hands-on training, learn what you need to know about the circulatory system, venipuncture technique and specimen collection, risk factors and complications, and quality assurance. This course provides a complete learning experience - with 48 hours of classroom instruction and a 40-hour hands-on externship, and prepares you to take the National Certification exam to become a Certified Phlebotomy Technician I (CPT I). A certificate of completion is awarded upon successful completion of the course.

You must be at least 18 years old and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Students will be required to wear Masks & Scrub uniform (any color) to class every week.

REQUIREMENTS: Minimum HS Diploma /GED, 18 years+, and Negative TB exam.

Please note: Some externship sites and/or future employers may require the COVID 19 vaccine.

BECOME A PHLEBOTOMIST IN 4 STEPS:

1. **Classroom Time:** 48 hours at Glendale College Garfield Campus
2. **National Exam:** 2 hours (to be scheduled by the student, additional information about the National Exam will be provided in class)
3. **Externship:** 40 hours in clinical setting
4. **Submit Documents** to the State of California

CERTIFICATION: Upon Completion of the program, the student will qualify to apply to the State of California as a Certified Phlebotomy Technician I (CPTI).

Your tuition includes books, supplies, study guides, all class materials, exam preparation and externship. Tuition does not include required State License fee of \$100, or the National Certification exam fee of \$125.

Pharmacy Technician Training Program

Online for 2023

Why wait to begin training for a rewarding career as a pharmacy technician? The pharmacy technician program at Glendale Community College takes a unique approach by combining online training and externship training! Unlike

self-paced, online programs, GCC's pharmacy technician program is taught in real-time by a live instructor in a virtual classroom using Zoom technology. This 260-hour program covers topics such as pharmacology for technicians, pharmacy law and regulations, sterile and non-sterile compounding, quality assurance, and medication safety. Supplies will be mailed to students and skills will be taught virtually.

Program includes a 120-hour externship where you will receive hands-on training in a pharmacy under the direction of a pharmacist. This

program fulfills the education requirements of the California Board of Pharmacy (Business and Professions Code Section 4202) for pharmacy technician licensure. Upon successful completion of the Pharmacy Technician program, you will be eligible to apply for your California Pharmacy Technician License.

Program at a Glance: Our program provides instruction in the following essential areas: • Screening prescription orders for accuracy and completeness • Preparing prescriptions – retrieve, count, pour, weigh, measure, and sometimes mix the medication • Performing calculations • Using technology to help maintain accurate patient records, prepare & package medications and place orders

• Understand the effect of medications on the body • Identifying the use, dosages and purposes of medications

Career Opportunities Graduates of this program may find career opportunities in the following areas: • Retail, Hospital, and Mail-order Pharmacies • Drug Companies • Education (PT instructor)

Pre-Requisites: You must be 18 years of age or older and have a High School diploma or equivalent (GED or HiSet); be proficient in keyboarding; understand computing and word processing; have good English language skills and Math skills. Students will need to have access to internet, PC, laptop, or tablet with webcam and access to a printer in order to participate. A clean background check is necessary for licensure in California.

Textbooks purchased separately: Textbooks should be ordered through the publisher. A link to order at a discounted rate will be emailed to students 3-4 weeks before the class begins.

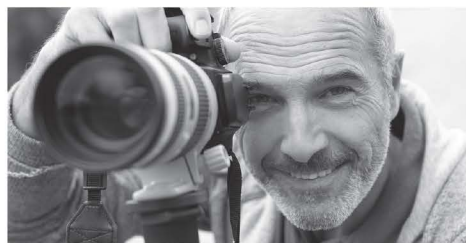

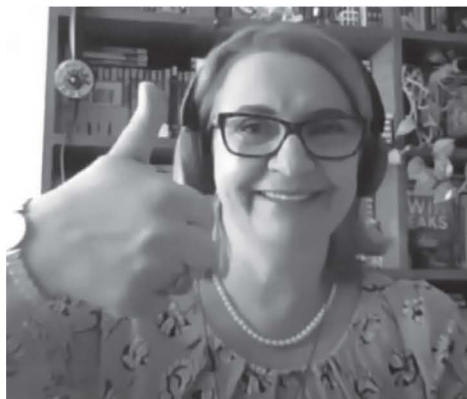

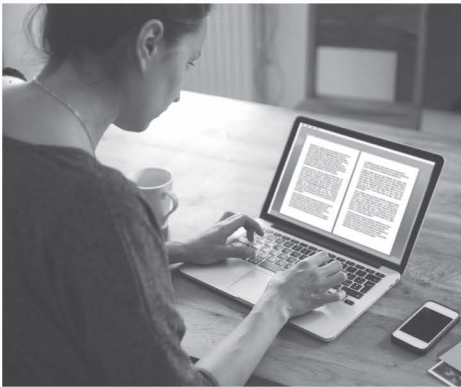

Cheech & Chino Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art & Culture: The Riverside Art Museum & BAPS Shri Swamina- rayan Mandir Hindu Temple With Riverside Food Lab

Welcome to The Cheech! The Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art & Culture is the newest addition to downtown Riverside's historic core. Comedian Cheech Marin – one half of the famous comedy duo, Cheech & Chong – amassed a collection of more than 700 paintings, drawings, sculptures and mixed-media works by Chicano artists over the last 30 years. He then donated the entire collection – considered the largest collection of Chicano art in the world – to create the museum! Housed in the former Riverside Public Library, it is the first museum in the United States devoted entirely to Chicano art and culture and has generated a Chicano art renaissance since its opening in 2022. We'll discover the rich history of Chicano Art while admiring almost 500 works including paintings, drawings, prints, sculpture and photography. We'll continue next door to the Riverside Museum of Art, housed in an architecturally significant 1929 building designed by Hearst Castle architect, Julia Morgan. The museum features a collection of approximately 2,000 traditional and contemporary art pieces that include photographs, mixed media works and paintings that provide visitors a sweeping

glimpse of the history of art. Enjoy time at leisure at the Riverside Food Lab, the food hall which features several grab-and-go artisanal eateries that celebrate Riverside's diverse cuisines and latest foodie trends! This afternoon we immerse ourselves in the glorious culture and faith of India at BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir – a traditional Hindu temple tucked away in Chino Hills. As an expression of their profound spirituality, Hindus create these dazzling mandirs that embody Hindu divinity and Indian architectural excellence while reflecting the divine faith, industry and skill of generations of Hindus. Enjoy time at leisure discovering the timeless traditions of ancient India, learning about the mandir's construction through inspiring images and facts, and admiring the magnificent architecture. You won't find any steel or metal here as every single piece of the temple is hand-carved – Italian marble on the inside and pink stone from Rajasthan, India on the outside. *This tour involves moderate walking and the removal of shoes to enter the Temple.*

Coronado Enchantment Guided Tour of the Hotel Del Coronado, New Hotel Del Coronado Museum & Coronado Village

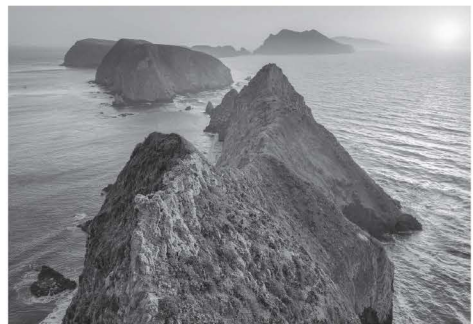

Anacapa Island Wildlife Cruise – Channel Islands National Park Visitor Center & Ventura Harbor Village

This fun and educational day provides the perfect way to discover Channel Islands National Park, a "treasure in the sea" that is close to the California mainland, yet worlds apart. Our exploration begins at the Channel Islands National Park Visitor Center, featuring a display of marine aquatic life, exhibits focused on the unique character of each island and an observation tower offering one of the best views of Ventura Harbor, the coastline and the Channel Islands. Enjoy time at leisure in the picturesque Ventura Harbor Village to take a leisurely stroll along the waterfront promenade and browse the boutiques and art galleries. Enjoy lunch on your own at a variety of casual waterfront eateries. This afternoon, we'll embark on a 3 ½ hour narrated wildlife cruise through the waters of Santa Barbara Channel, Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary and Channel Islands National Park. On this non-landing cruise, we'll journey along the rugged shoreline and surrounding waters of Anacapa Island with views of the famous Arch Rock, the working lighthouse atop the island and a variety of wildlife. Channel Islands National Park and its ocean environment preserves and protects a wealth of natural and cultural resources. Isolation over thousands of years has created unique animals, plants, and archeological resources found nowhere else on Earth and helped preserve a place where visitors can experience coastal southern California as it once was. Our large passenger vessel features a restroom onboard and offers both indoor and outdoor seating on multiple decks. While traveling across the Santa Barbara Channel our journey may be highlighted by wildlife sightings including dolphins, sea lions and birds.

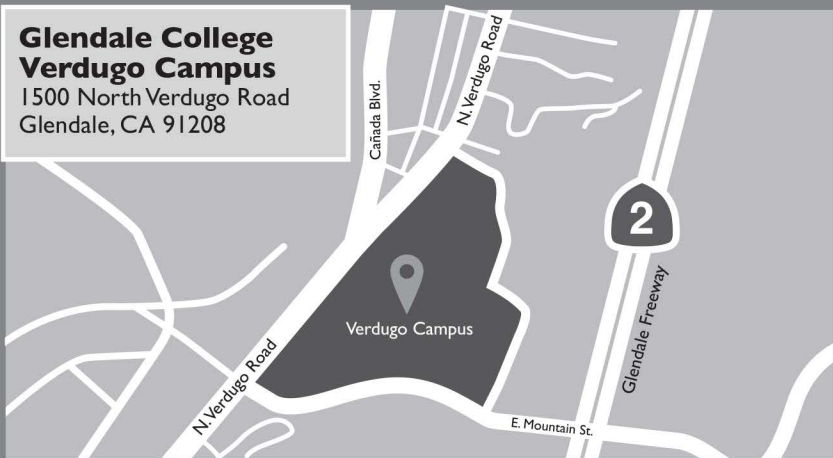
