# **XII.** Report of Officers

- Ani Chaglasian: Academic senate hearing, both amendments failed. Pay attention to future meetings and see if we can be a part of it and have a say in it when something is important to us.
- Part of the finance committee did outreach to some of the colleges to find out if they pay for attending governments and found out that for LA city college they pay a stipend of \$400 per semester. Not only for governances but also for regular AS activities. There is a request form in order to receive the payment there are requirements and needs to follow strict rules in order to qualify for the stipend.

#### XIII. Special Reports/Governance Committee

- 1. Governance review: Areg Hovhannisyan
  - Talked about the recent senate voting that we discussed last leg, and discussed how to move forward around this potential vote.
  - Discussed ZTC and LTC committee. These are policies and procedures we put together
    for courses that have no or low textbook costs. We want to set these committees up.
     Would have two AS reps and would report to academic affairs
  - Some concerns would be funding and finding cost effective ways of cutting down these costs for textbooks
  - Another concern is that some people feel like this is bureaucratic red tape that will harm students more than it helps
  - Other colleges addressed these issues but we haven't
  - Elected new governance review chair
  - Was told to bring this action item back to allow people outside of AS to be in governances such as black scholars and La comunidad

- I told them that anyone who paid the SRF is an AS member and so they can join. Need to check on ledge what the process is

# 2. Campus Development: Areg Hovhannisyan

The meeting started with the discussion of the Reintroduction and Refurbishment of the bulletin boards on the Verdugo Campus. Some of the suggested locations were the bridge elevators, hallways of SV, and the downstairs lobby. The downstairs lobby closest to the elevators would be chosen. The bridge elevators on the bottom floor would be the best to present the other bulletin boards. Another proposed location would be alongside the SG location by the White Hut. There is another existing bulletin board in the SR building that could be another proposed location. The recommendation would be to reintroduce and refurbish the six bulletin boards. Students didn't have access to put out advertisements, announcements, or club information throughout the campus. Bulletin boards would be a sufficient idea to present this information to students. Some concerns of the reintroduction of the bulletin boards would be the exposed materials of possible hate speech crime or vandalism. As a possible solution, ASGCC/facilities could be looking out every now and then to make sure that all the bulletin boards have no hate speech presented. We motioned to approve the reintroduction and refurbishment of the bulletin boards in order for students to get adequate access to new information around campus. The removal of the sand box could possibly be replaced by a music technology/recording studio. Some of the concerns of the new music technology could be the noise and if it could possibly affect the learning environment. The list of equipment needs to be envisioned and what structural layout would be beneficial to

create the space. The largest concern would be the noise and how we can prevent it from happening.

3. Environment and Sustainability: Ani Chaglasian

Michael Reed initially started up the environment and sustainability committee, being a

division chair, then later passing that role onto the facilities chair, Patrick Shahnazarian.

He discussed how we are all facing a climate crisis, and his history teaching climate

change, emphasizing the importance of it. Michael Reed proceeded to do a presentation

discussing potential solar panels at GCC. He showed a comparison of Glendale High,

considering how they have gone solar, and saying that we are behind on this.

Furthermore, he spoke on the heat records in LA and how they've significantly risen in

the recent years. He discussed the expenses as well as the process of his home system

with solar panels when he bought a house, and compared it to the potential prices that

Glendale College would be facing and the ratio of cost effectiveness. He additionally

spoke on how much solar panels exponentially decreased his carbon footprint, by

reducing fossil fuel. He discussed the inflation reduction act and how it opens solar

opportunities for schools.
