- CO4: BIOL 102, 122, 125; GEOG 106, 107; NUTR 125

**Note:** After matriculation to the University of Nevada, Reno, students may not take substitute courses for Core Humanities/CO5. Students must satisfy any remaining CO5 requirements by completing the required CH courses.
