



Select Pass/No Pass: How to Change the Grading Basis for a Class to Pass/No Pass through MyGCC

**Changing from a graded course to the P/NP option may have a negative effect on your financial aid eligibility for future terms. *Courses with the Pass/No Pass grade option will be indicated on the student's permanent record as "P" with units earned and no grade points or "NP" with no units earned and no grade points.

*A Pass/No Pass grade will be counted in the calculations for, academic probation and dismissal, and as an enrollment attempt. The student is required to take all tests, complete all assignments, and shall be subject to withdrawal and attendance regulations.

*Each college/university has its own policy on courses taken for Pass/No Pass related to admissions, transfer credit, prerequisites, graduation, and other academic requirements. It is the student's responsibility to verify the Pass/No Pass policies of individual transfer institutions or graduate/professional schools.



Students will not be permitted to petition later to change a received letter grade of A - F, or change a Pass/No Pass symbol to a letter grade.**




