## Suggested Sequence for Architecture Classes

Students should use the following guide as a suggested sequence for taking classes for completion of the Architecture Certificate.

<b>First Semester/Session</b>	Arch 101, Art 130 or Art 150, Required Speech Class, Required English Class, and/or Required Math Class.
<b>Second Semester/Session</b>	Arch 102 or 141 or 250, 103, 105, 106, 108, 109, and/or Engr 109.
<b>Third Semester/Session</b>	Arch 120 (If Arch 102 was completed), Arch 125 (If Arch 120 was completed), Arch 130 (if Arch 102 was taken), Arch 142 or 143 (if Arch 141 was taken), Arch 229 (if Arch 250 or Engr 109 was taken), Arch 251 and/or 252 (if Arch 250 was taken), plus any classes needed from the second semester.
<b>Forth Semester/Session</b>	Arch 135 (If Arch 130 was completed), Arch 240 (If Arch 120, 130, and 250 were completed), plus any classes needed from the second and third semesters.

Note: Some classes listed above may not be available. These classes may be substituted with other classes. See the Department Chair, Dave Martin for more information.

- The Architecture Certificate may take longer than four semesters to complete.
- Please see the department webpage for class names and descriptions. The certificate is a total of 42-46 units.
- Some classes listed above are not required for the certificate. See certificate requirements for required classes.
