

CSU General Education Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) Requirements and CSU GE Breadth for STEM

Completion of all the requirements in the CSU General Education Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) meet lower-division general education requirements at a California State University (CSU) without the need after transfer to take additional lower-division general education courses.

CSU GE Breadth for STEM is a separate CSU GE Breadth track available for students planning to major in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics. CSU will only accept CSU GE Breadth for STEM if a student is earning an Associate of Science for Transfer (AS-T) in Biology. Students will be required to complete additional lower-division general education courses upon transfer to the CSU.

All courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better. Courses appearing in more than one area may be used to satisfy only <u>one</u> area. Semesters/years in parentheses indicate the semester/year the course was approved for this area on CSU GE.
