

## Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) and IGETC for STEM

Completion of all the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) meet lower-division general education requirements at either a California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) without the need after transfer to take additional lower-division general education courses.

IGETC for STEM is a separate IGETC track available for students planning to major in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics. UC and CSU will only accept IGETC for STEM if a student is earning an Associate of Science for Transfer (AS-T) in Biology, and if the major program or college applied to accepts partial IGETC certification. Students will be required to complete additional lower-division general education courses upon transfer to the UC or CSU.

All courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better. Courses appearing in more than one area may be used to satisfy only one area. Semesters/years in parentheses indicate when the course was approved for this area on IGETC.
