XIII. Special Reports/Governance Committee

1. Environment & Sustainability – Kelin Minasian, Merissa Shahbazian

- We began our meeting by talking about how great Earth Day was. The Covid-19 pandemic caused a
 loss of momentum for returning students, which resulted in a lower turnout for the Earth Day event.
 Nevertheless, this year's Earth Day was extremely successful, and we're just trying to improve for
 next year.
- To improve the event and increase participation, we began organizing the following Earth Day event.
- We also thought of offering a spin-the-wheel game where students could win free donations for items like notebooks, water bottles, sweaters, and tote bags from the student bookstore.
- Following that, we discussed how Southland Disposal, our waste management firm, rates the bottles and cans from our main trash cans and offers us better discounted pricing for the recycled materials.
- 42.7% of our trash cans were recycled, and the state was informed of this. Out of the 541 tons of waste that the college disposed of, 231 tons were recycled.

2. Campus Development – Ani Isiants, Isabelle Karayan

- We talked about construction of the new science building representing a significant investment of over \$130 million to expand instructional space.
- Successes include the expansion of the Vaquero Athletics Center, acquisition, and expansion of space at Garfield, and other meaningful projects. However, progress on the Performing and Fine Arts Complex has been limited.
- Data shows that students are gradually returning to campus, emphasizing the importance of addressing their needs now to ensure readiness for future generations.
- A new project focused on growing healthy food on a small scale aims to address food insecurity and provide job training opportunities. Aligning with GCC's goal of serving the community and promoting health and sustainability.
