Administrative Regulation 2511: Governance Document was reviewed and revised by the Governance Review Committee. This two-year effort resulted in clearer section titles, addition of a table of contents with links to within the document, and new sections to clarify adding members; and to define how an agenda item moves through governance from idea, to discussion, to implementation.
