III. New Business

Articulation update (Bershad)

Title 5 Implementation of Ethnic Studies and the Cultural Diversity Requirement (Rohrbaher, Ritterbrown, Bershad)

- 1. We'd like to propose redefining our current CD requirement to Global Awareness/Appreciation (or similar). Courses in this area will encourage students to take courses outside of the Ethnic Studies requirement. This requirement is in line with GCC's ILO #6: Global, Cultural, Social, and Environmental Responsibility
 - Yvette Y.: She can map this in eLumen and send it to the committee. Beth K.: 48s count for Global Awareness Aisha C.: The intent should be made clear. Fran: Should the ILO be used as the basis? Ed K.: We need to explain why ETH S is not included in ILO #6.
- 2. Divisions will decide which courses fulfill this requirement. Bridget B.: Ask divisions to start bringing it up now. She also showed the GE change crosswalk and will send it to the committee.
- 3. These courses should be double-counted. Bridget B.: 48s won't double count.
- 4. In this process, divisions should look at all Graduation Requirements areas to see what courses should be added/deleted to our local requirements.

The process for completing this change:

- 1. Discuss this change at C&I on 12/13
- 2. Discuss this change at C&I again Feb. 21. Possibly vote on redefining CD to Global Awareness/Appreciation
- 3. C&I Reps take this change to their division and discuss the change, decide which courses would be appropriate for a Global Awareness/Appreciation graduation requirement and vote on these changes.
- 4. C&I Reps bring these changes to the C&I committee and the committee votes on adding courses to the Global Awareness/Appreciation Graduation Requirement.
- 5. This change goes to Academic Affairs (and to Graduation Requirements if there is disagreement between C&I and Academic Affairs—see p. 86 of C&I Handbook). Changes go on to College Exec and BoT.

Stray thoughts/observations:

- 1. Should Division Chairs meet to communicate about these changes— which courses should be a part of a Global Appreciation/Awareness requirement?
- 2. Francien will make it clear in the C&I agenda when the redefinition of CD to Global Awareness/Appreciation is being discussed/voted on, and when curriculum items are on the agenda to be placed into this requirement.
- 3. We should be prepared to answer questions about whether we have too many local requirements (there may be push back about adding another local requirement for our local degrees).

4. From AR 4000: Procedure for establishing graduation requirements: Procedures for establishing graduation requirements will be reviewed by the Graduation Requirements Committee in consultation with the C & I Committee, reporting to the Academic Senate, and referred to the Academic Affairs Committee for advisory consultation. The Academic Affairs Committee will return the proposed requirements to the Academic Senate.

If changes are proposed by the Academic Affairs Committee, the Academic Senate shall approve or disapprove those changes. If the Academic Senate approves the changes, the revised requirements will be referred to the Academic Affairs Committee for review and sent to College Executive
