EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PACKS

The Child Development Center has a comprehensive disaster and emergency preparedness plan on file that you are encouraged to review. The parent section of that plan will be given to you upon your child's enrollment. You will need to prepare an emergency back pack for your child in addition to other food, medical, and emergency supplies you may be asked to donate. The back pack should include the following items. Mark the child's full name clearly on the outside of the bag.

1. A change of clothes, including a change of socks
2. Additional underwear/diapers
3. Sweatshirt or light jacket
4. Small blanket or thermal blanket
5. Any medication your child must take with written permission for us to administer it
6. A 3x5 Card with your child's name, address, telephone number and out-of-state phone number family contact
7. Copy of: Authorization of Consent to Treat Minor
8. Complete Names of Authorized Persons to Take Child from Center During Disaster
9. A photo of your family
10. A small cuddly toy
11. A favorite book or two
12. Small flashlight and batteries
13. Children Face mask (qty.2 masks)
