New Business

Articulation update (Bershad)

The articulation timeline and other articulation information on the GCC website were reviewed.

Curriculum Institute 2024 takeaways (Vera, Bershad, Traynor)

Title 5 has to be finished very soon. Common course numbering is starting.

Title 5 Task Force (Vera)

This task force will recommend the minimum number of GE units that a local AA and AS require starting Fall 2025. Title 5 requires minimum 21 units, but college can add local requirements. Other colleges have reduced GE units to as low as minimum 21 units, allowing for double counting, waiving units for high-unit majors. Committee members asked which students choose to do local GE vs. other options. Per student reps, many students do not look at which courses double count. Task force recommendations will presented at the October 11 meeting.

 - 2. Any program listed in Fall 2023 as needing an update needs <u>at least</u> to be in Create stage by the last meeting in Fall 2025. If not, this program will be sent to Academic Senate to begin archiving.
 - 3. Courses and programs are allowed one revision per academic year.
