Join GCC professors Zohara Kaye and Sevada Chamras on this 2-week exploration of the culture and society of Armenia. Students must enroll in Library International Field Studies (2 units).

The program will be based in central Yerevan, Armenia, the "Pink City." The program includes visits to sites of cultural and historical significance - including UNESCO world heritage sites of Geghard and Sanahin - along with lectures and discussions.

## **Program Includes:**

13 nights accommodation based on twin occupancy

- 9 nights in Yerevan
- 2 nights in Dilijan
- 2 nights in Gyumri

Daily breakfast, 6 lunches, welcome dinner, farewell dinner, airport transfers, and land transportation as part of the program itinerary. Entry to cultural sites including Yerevan city tour, History Museum of Armenia, and Folk Art Museum. Other sites are Tsitsernakabert, Garni Pagan Temple, Zarni-Parni Cave Castle, Sanahin, Lake Sevan, Dilijan ("Armenian Switzerland"), and Gyumri.

**Not Included:** Airfare of approximately \$1,600+, GCC tuition & fees, beverages, meals & activities not part of the itinerary, travel insurance (approx. \$100), spending money (approx. \$500).
