- Thank you, guys, for making the time to let me chat today. My name is Zoila, I am one of the nurses down over at the healthcare center. We want to bridge your health and academia by expanding our access to healthcare for our Glendale Community College community. The health center provides in-person health and wellness. We have mental health services, we do vaccines, we have over the counter medications. We have nurses on site, but we're only open Monday through Friday.
- Timely is a telehealth service that is able to provide 24/7 care that is also 365, so you're looking at nights, weekends, holidays, during break, when the health center is not open. It's launched already so they're up and running. You guys have the time to sign up for it. Some of the stuff that we also have scheduled consultations with, not just consultations, but whole sessions with therapists that are also available for students who are off campus or who have a busy schedule. The purpose of me being here today is to inform all of you guys about the services and how we are expanding our health services to provide to students.
