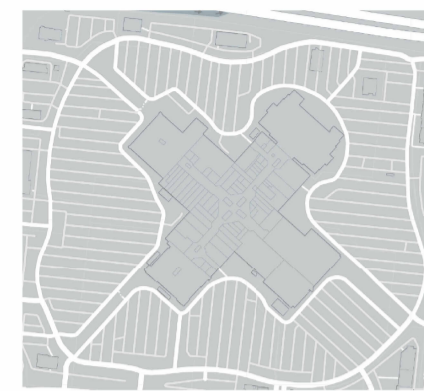


CUMULUS CLOUD HABITAT

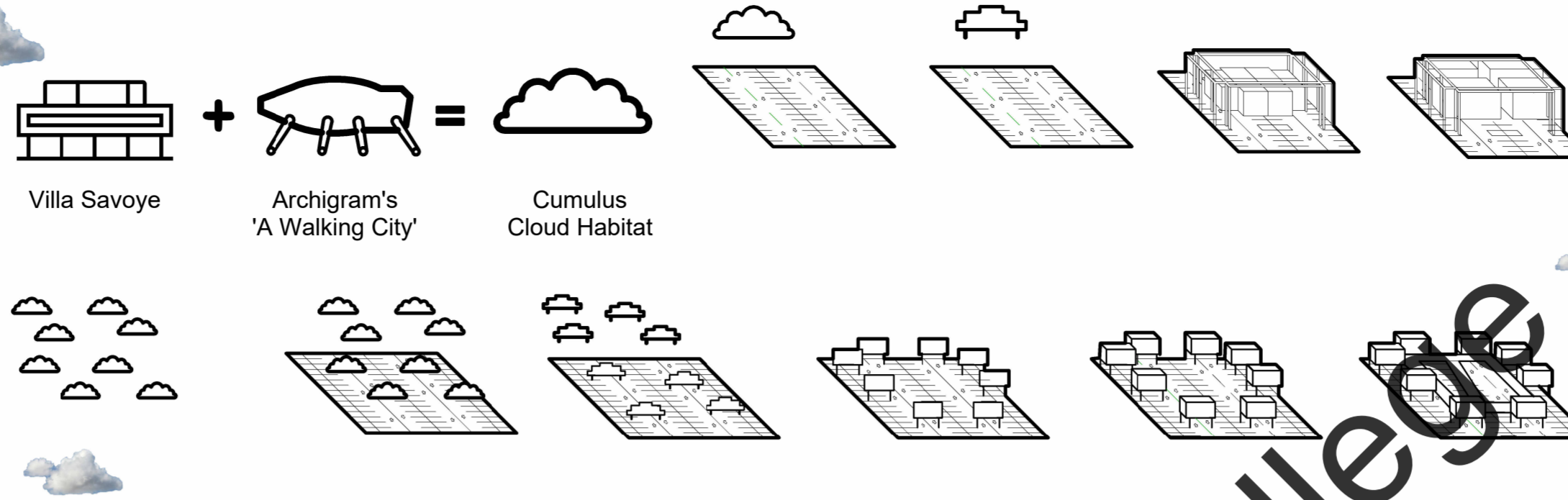


Mall with "Sea of Parking"

Central Circulation

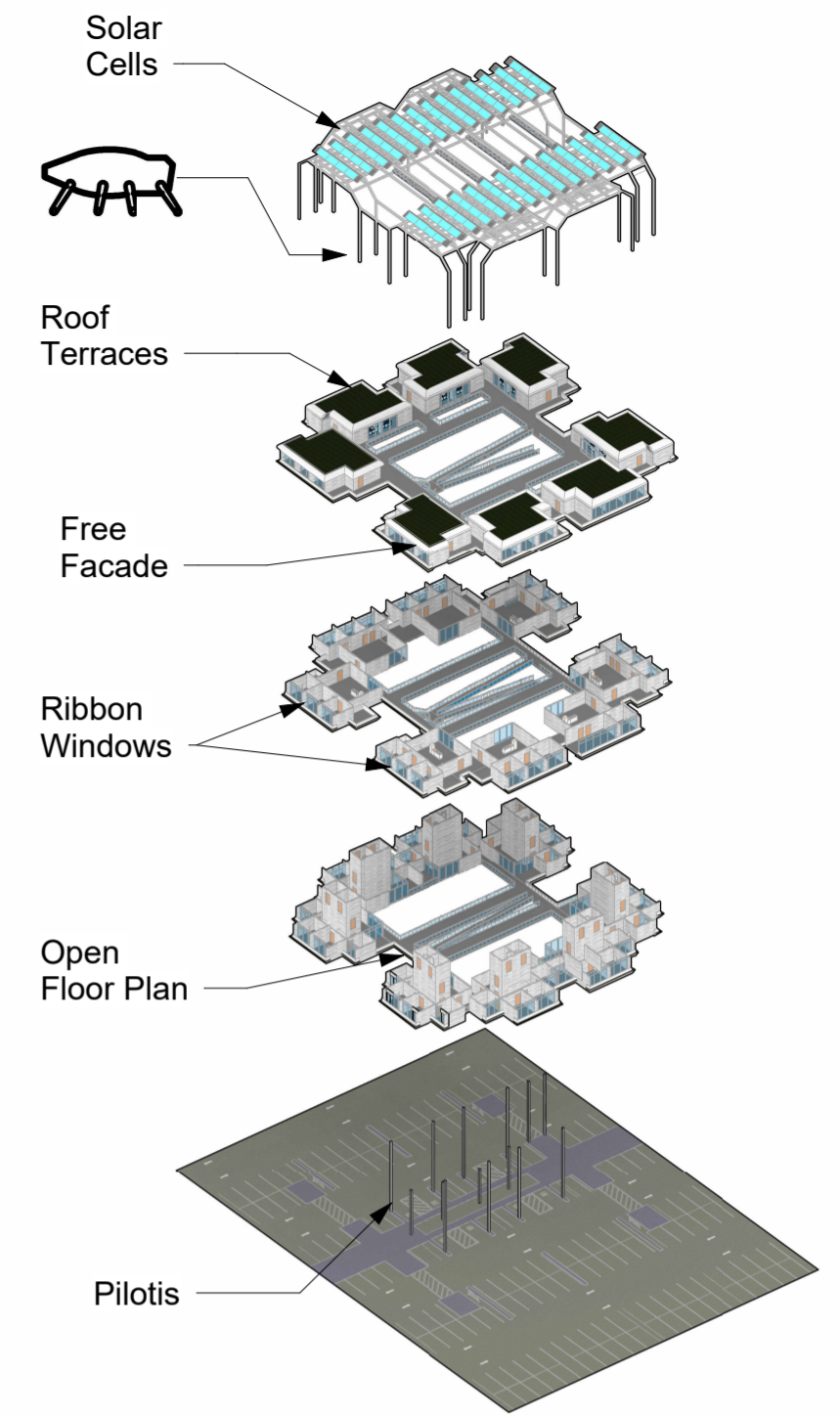


Parking Level- Ramp View

Five Points of Architecture

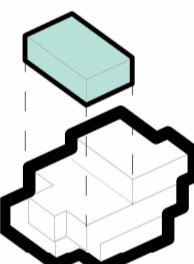
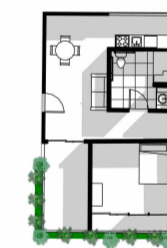


Overall View of The Cumulus Cloud Habitat

One Branch of the Habitat Consists of Four Parts

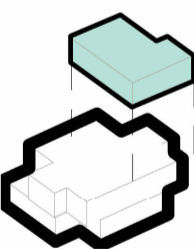
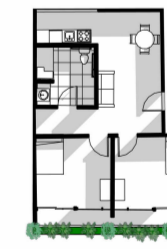
One Bedroom Unit

Located on the 3rd Floor, Eight Units In One Habitat



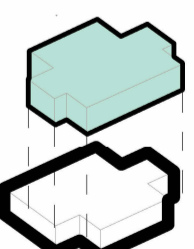
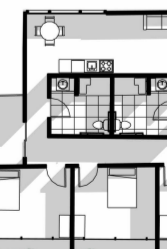
Two Bedroom Unit
