Academic Calendar

The academic year consists of 175 days of instruction, and the Flexible days are considered part of the 175 days of instruction. Statutory holidays are observed on the dates noted or on alternate dates in accordance with Education Code 79020, and include:

- New Year's Day (January 1)
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
- Lincoln Day (February 12 or see Note below)
- Washington Day (Third Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
- Armenian Genocide Remembrance Day (April 24)
- Independence Day (July 4)
- Labor Day (First Monday in September)
- Veterans Day (November 11 or see Note below)
- Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
- Christmas Day (December 25)
- Cesar Chavez Day and Native American Day are local options if collectively bargained

Other Holidays: The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the College and offices when good reason exists. These holidays traditionally have been New Year's Eve day, the day after Thanksgiving, and Christmas Eve day.

The academic calendar must be approved by the Board of Trustees annually.

Note: Education Code 79020 addresses the scheduling of Lincoln Day, Veterans Day and holidays that fall on weekends.
