Please be aware that if you are a U.S. citizen, **you will need a passport to re-enter the U.S.**, so make sure to make the necessary arrangements to obtain one prior to the start of your classes. If you are not a U.S. citizen, you will also need a permanent resident card or a visa to travel between the U.S. and Mexico.

We also ask that you contact the instructor in charge of the session you are interested in, so that you may have an opportunity to ask specific questions about hers/his courses. The Baja California Field Studies Program **Glendale Community College Additional Information / Terms / Conditions**

The Baja California Field Studies Program classes take advantage of the natural and cultural environments of the Baja California Peninsula in Mexico. Our courses tend to be field based and most require active participation in outdoor activities such as swimming, hiking and overnight camping. All courses are intensive and cover the same amount of material as when taught at the college main campus during regular semesters and inter-sessions. In order to participate, you must be able to study and live in close quarters with other students. Furthermore, this program entails working cooperatively with other students and instructors within the environment of a field station located in a foreign country.

There will be a mandatory pre-trip orientation session. You will be notified at a later date of the date, time and location of the meeting. If unable to attend, you are required to find someone else who can be present at this meeting on your behalf.

The listed costs for each program do not include: college registration fees, some meals, textbooks, passport, visa, snorkeling equipment and any expense of a purely personal nature. The \$100.00 application fee, which must be submitted with the completed application package, is non-refundable, unless the program you are applying to is cancelled. You will be notified of class acceptance within two weeks from the day on which we receive your application. Upon class acceptance, you will be required to make a \$100.00 payment. Both the original application fee and the payment you make upon class acceptance will be applied toward the total cost of the program you are applying to. If you drop between 60 and 31 days before the first day of classes, you will be responsible for 50% of the rest of the cost of the program. If you drop between 30 days and the day before the class starts, you will be responsible for 75% of the rest of the cost of the program. All costs of the program are due in our office two weeks before classes start. There will be no refunds once a class has begun. All requests for refunds must be in writing. Postmark date will be used to determine if any refunds are applicable.

The Baja California Field Studies Program Glendale Community College Student Conduct Policy

For more than thirty-five years, the Baja California Field Studies Program has provided students with the unique opportunity to study and learn in a natural environment, and a culture different than at home. We feel that anyone with a desire to learn, experience nature, and live cooperatively with others will profit from this experience. Nevertheless, these classes are not for everyone. Students must be willing to live closely with others, to adapt to changing logistical circumstances, and to study intensely over a short period of time.

Students must understand that this is an academic program, which takes place in a foreign country at a facility of Glendale Community College (Estación del Mar Cortés). Students must follow the Standards of Student Conduct as stated in the Administrative Regulation 5420.

Students shall respect the laws of our host country, Mexico, and behave in a manner that is respectful to the communities we visit.

Approximately once a week, each student will have clean-up duty and will be expected to participate in the upkeep of the field station. Participants also help the full-time station cook with meal preparation, serving and clean up.

Students will follow all the guidelines regarding safety and the use of equipment provided by the program's staff upon arrival at the field station. The instructors are in charge of the program and the students shall follow their academic regulations as set forth in their class syllabus.

If a student disregards any of the guidelines of student conduct listed above, the instructors in charge of the program may take action by expelling the student from the program and sending him/her back to the U.S. using a Mexican Bus Transportation Company.
