COURSE REPETITION

Students may repeat a course to alleviate substandard academic performance that has been previously recorded at Glendale Community College. Substandard academic performance is a grade of D, F, NP or NC. The Superintendent/President, or designee, in consultation with the Academic Senate shall establish administrative regulations to implement this policy.

When course repetition occurs, the permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, insuring a true and complete academic history.

Under special circumstances, students may repeat courses in which a C or better grade was earned. The special circumstances are defined in administrative regulations.
