Administrative Regulation

COURSE REPETITION – VARIABLE UNITS

Students may be permitted to enroll in variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses as many times as necessary to enable them to complete the entire curriculum of the course once as long as the courses are not cooperative work experience courses which are variable unit and open-entry/open-exit.

After successfully completing the course, students may not repeat variable unit open entry/open-exit courses unless:

- The course is required for legally mandated training; or
- The course is a special class for students with disabilities which needs to be repeated; or
- Repetition of the course is justified by extenuating circumstances; or
- A significant amount of time has elapsed since a student's initial successful completion of a course; or
- The student wishes to repeat the course to alleviate substandard work.

Whenever a student enrolls for a subsequent time in a physical education activity course offered for open entry/open exit, the enrollment will count as a repetition of the course.
